- 1. Obtain Certified Copies of the Death Certificate
 - a. If the death occurred in San Bernardino County, a certified copy of the death certificate may be obtained from the <u>Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector</u>, 222 W. Hospitality Lane, 1st floor, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0022, (909) 387-8314. Certified copies may be required for each separate agency.
 - b. Should the death occur in another county or state, a certified copy of the death certificate should be obtained from the appropriate authority.
 - c. If cause of death stated is pending, some of the agencies below may not accept the death certificate. Contact the individual organizations listed below to determine their requirements.
